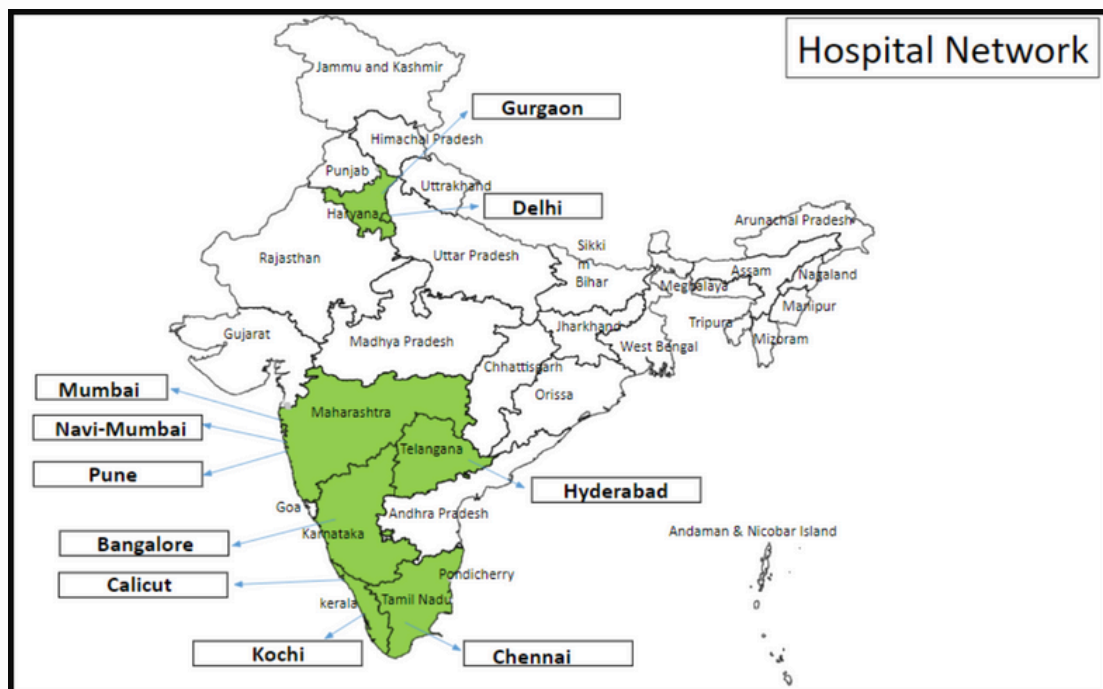

Meet two of our beneficiaries nearing completion of 1 year of transplants



A 10-month-old Vinayak faced Decompensated Cryptogenic Liver Cirrhosis, requiring a lifesaving transplant. His parents, Mehul and Krupaleeben Jaysval, sought help from Dr. Gaurav Patel at Nanavati Max Hospital, Mumbai. Financial constraints loomed, but support from TPAF and other foundations ensured funds for the transplant.

On 31st August, 2023, Vinayak underwent a successful transplant. After 14 days in the hospital, he's now on the path to recovery, expected to fully heal within the next six months. Vinayak's story highlights the importance of community support and resilience in overcoming adversity.
